Proof of identity requirements

Applying for registration from within Australia

All applicants must provide sufficient evidence of their identity when applying for registration being:

- · one document from each category A, B and C, and
- one document from Category D if the document supplied for category B or C does not contain evidence of a current Australian residential address.

The name displayed on the Category A document will be the name used for registration and will be published on the Register of practitioners.

Evidence for a change of name or name variation

You must attach to your application a certified copy of evidence of a change of name if:

- you have ever been formally known by another name(s), or
- any of the documents you provide in support of your application is in another name(s).

Evidence could include a marriage certificate, change of name certificate, or deed poll. A <u>Commonwealth of Australia Statutory Declaration</u> may only be used to explain the reason for a name variation, not for change of a legal name.

Applying for registration from outside of Australia

If you are an overseas applicant and are unable to provide evidence from each category, you must meet the **minimum identity requirements** below:

- a certified copy of a passport (an EU card is not acceptable), and
- if you have ever been formally known by another name, or if your documents provided in support of your application are in another name, you must provide a certified copy of evidence of a change in name. See Evidence for a change of name or name variation.

If you have met the minimum identity requirements and have submitted a complete application (all supporting documentation provided and declarations made), your application will be assessed and you will be advised whether you are eligible for registration.

Overseas applicants eligible for registration who only provide the minimum identity requirements must present in person at an AHPRA office before registration will be granted.

Presentation is to be within the specified timeframe as advised in the notice of in-principle approval and with the following evidence:

If you arrived in Australia within the previous six weeks:

- Current Australian visa and proof of date of arrival (e.g. entry stamp, boarding pass or itinerary documents) plus:
 - evidence of your current Australian residential address, or
 - an original signed statement from a prospective
 Australian employer/sponsor verifying your identity, or
 - an original offer of Australian employment.



If you arrived in Australia more than six weeks before presenting at an AHPRA office or you are unable to demonstrate that you arrived in Australia within the previous six weeks:

 Evidence that meets the requirements in categories A, B, C and D.

International medical graduates applying for limited, provisional or specialist registration

The Medical Board of Australia requires that international medical graduates¹ present in person to an AHPRA office, with their proof of identity, if they have not been previously registered as a medical practitioner with limited or provision registration under the National Registration and Accreditation Scheme before registration will be granted for limited, provisional or specialist registration.

General criteria

- All identity documents must be certified copies of the original as per AHPRA's <u>Certifying documents guidelines</u>.
- All documents not originally written in English must be translated as per AHPRA's <u>Translating document</u> guidelines.
- At least one document must include a recent photograph (see Category B).
- At least one document must be in the applicant's current name.
- You must only use each document once for category A, B or C.

Verifying identity - online applications

AHPRA uses an electronic platform, greenIDTM, to assist with real time, online verification of identity documents against government data sources (Document Verification Service – DVS). For select online applications, individuals may upload ID documents for verification through greenIDTM as part of the application process. Documents verified using greenIDTM will still need to be certified in line with AHPRA's guidelines. The following documents can be verified using greenIDTM:

- Australian Birth Certificate
- Australian passport
- New Zealand passport
- Australian visa
- ImmiCard
- Australian citizenship certificate
- Australian passport
- Australian motor vehicle licence
- Australian marriage certificate
- Australian name change certificate

¹ International medical graduates (IMGs) whose medical qualifications are from a medical school outside of Australia or New Zealand and who are seeking registration to practise medicine in Australia.
